Excel receives liquids, sludge, and solid waste materials at the site in either drums, totes, or in bulk. The incoming waste material is evaluated according to the Waste Analysis Plan, and either accepted or rejected. Accepted waste goes to either the permitted container storage building, one of two hazardous waste storage tanks, or directly to the process area for blending and shipment offsite. Wastes are pumped from containers by a suction pump, through a filter basket, and either into storage tanks or directly to a tank truck for shipment offsite.
